

# Oregon Fest 2018

*"Life's a Picnic....JOIN IN!"*

**Sunday, May 20, 2018 \* Noon-6 \* Dustin Road, Oregon OH**

**Join us as we celebrate the 24<sup>th</sup> Oregon Fest! The one day event includes family activities, a Business Fair, Arts and Crafts, Food Vendors, a classic car show, amusements and contests. Come and be a part of this community festival!**

- Booths in the **BUSINESS FAIR** area are for businesses, civic organizations, churches and others showcasing their business or community offerings.
- Booths in the **ARTS AND CRAFTS** area are for vendors selling homemade items for home and family.
- Food Vendor participation is by invitation only.
- **SPONSORSHIP** opportunities and benefits are described in accompanying information.

## Exhibitor Rules

All booths must be paid in full by check at the time of registration. There will NOT be any registrations on site the day of the festival.

Registration deadline is April 30. No refunds will be issued except at the discretion of the Oregon Fest Committee. A service charge of \$25 will be assessed for returned checks.

Booth size is 10 feet by 10 feet on grass or blacktop.

Exhibitors should bring their own tents, tables, and chairs. As a convenience for vendors, tables and chairs can be rented and provided on Fest day at the booth. Rental must be included with registration.

Tents must be free-standing and cannot be anchored in grass or blacktop. Weights must be used to keep all property secure. The exhibitor will be responsible for all damage caused by their booth and fixtures.

Set up if from 10-11:30 a.m. All vehicles must off Dustin Rd by 11:30. Parking is outside the festival area.

Booths must be staffed during festival hours and displays must be open during festival hours. No displays are to be dismantled prior to the festival's closing at 6 except for severe weather.

All activities must be from your booth area. No signs, displays, handouts or soliciting attendees are allowed away from the allotted booth area. Loud music, shouting, or anything amplified is not permitted.

All items and materials for display and sale must be family-friendly and legal. The Oregon Fest Committee reserves the right to prohibit items deemed inappropriate and may require removal of any vendors not complying with the rules of Oregon Fest.

Sales and taxes are the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.

Exhibitors cannot offer food or drink (including bottled water, coffee, cookies) either complimentary or for sale with the exception of small wrapped candy as a give-away item.

There is limited electricity available for exhibits on a first-come basis. Power must be limited to 110 volts (household current). Gas generators are prohibited.

For the safety of all, pets, bicycles, skateboards, scooters and any non-assistance wheeled items should not be brought to the festival.

Final booth arrangements and set-up instructions will be available 10 days prior to the event.
